2020 AEMA Annual Meeting Short Course Chair Responsibilities

FINANCES

AEMA does not revenue share the short courses. We depend on our members support to put on the course. We will either publish or reimburse you for your costs to publish your class materials. The due date for course materials to be at our office is in your Due Date Schedule.

All short course chairs must be current AEMA members or be employed by one. We will comp your course registration and also full technical session registration. We will comp short course registration for short course speakers provided they are either individual members of AEMA, one of the two corporate representatives of a member company, or employed by a member company. The exception to this is employees of the federal government and state regulatory agencies & geological surveys. This exception DOES NOT apply to college or university professors or other employees of colleges and universities who are not associated with the state geological survey/bureau of mines. Non-member speakers will be required to pay 50% of the course fee. Chair and Speakers must register before the Advanced Registration deadline of November 15 to avoid a \$50 late fee for on site registration. ***All organizers and speakers must register prior to speaking in the course - No Exceptions***

RESPONSIBILITIES

Throughout the planning and execution of AEMA's Annual Meeting, chairs of sessions and workshops serve as liaisons between the Conference Committee Program Coordinators and the event's participants to shape and define the event and each speaker's role.

Short course chairs stay in contact with their speakers and make suggestions to keep them to the theme of the course and the agenda you have set out. They also work with speakers to determine time allotments, the order of presentations and any a/v requests.

It is the duty of the short course chair to impress upon your speakers the importance of learning their material. They should not be reading their slides. Verbiage on slides should be kept to a minimum.

We ask the short course chairs to load all talks on their personal laptop for their course. If you do not have access to one, make a note on the AV form. I will make arrangements to have one in your classroom.
