2023 AEMA Annual Meeting Technical Session Chair Responsibilities

RESPONSIBILITIES

Throughout the planning and execution of AEMA's Annual Meeting, chairs of sessions and workshops serve as liaisons between the Conference Committee Program Coordinators and the event's participants to shape and define the event and each speaker's role.

Session chairs stay in contact with their speakers and make suggestions to keep them to the theme of the Annual Meeting and the session description you have set out. They also work with speakers to determine time allotments, the order of presentations and any AV requests. It is the duty of the chair to impress upon your speakers the importance of learning their material. They should not be reading their slides. Verbiage on slides should be kept to a minimum.

All session chairs must be current AEMA members or be employed by one. The same exception below applies to organizers. We will comp chair and co-chair technical session registration. We will comp technical session registration for one speaker per talk provided they are either individual members of AEMA, one of the two corporate representatives of a member company, or employed by a member company. The exception to this is employees of the federal government and state regulatory agencies & geological surveys. This exception DOES NOT apply to college or university professors or other employees of colleges and universities who are not associated with the state geological survey/bureau of mines. Non-member speakers will be required to pay the member rate for registration (\$400). Any chair or speaker who has not registered by the Advanced Registration Deadline of November 19 will be charged an additional \$50 and they will have to register on site. **All chairs and speakers must register prior to speaking in the session. No exceptions.**

As you place your speakers, please fill in the information on the enclosed speaker information sheet. This sheet must be completed and returned to me on or before August 15. If you have changes, please let me know right away.

When you receive a paper proposal from the Call for Papers, please contact the author. Let them know you received it, are interested in it, it does not fit the scope of your session, etc. If you decline a paper, please let the author know as soon as possible. If you think it may be a fit for a different session, please return the paper to me with a comment to that effect. We suggest no more than five talks to a session. Remember, your session is not an advertisement for your company. Speakers must be from multiple companies.

We ask the session chairs to load all talks on their personal laptop for their session. If you do not have access to one, make a note on the AV form. We will make arrangements to have one in your session.
